Then you will enjoy this peaceful getaway. The retreat has been happening for 5 years. We have been predominantly a Quilt Retreat for those years, but many of the women who attend also knit. Many churches have Knitting ministries. So we have combined the two.

The retreat is limited to 45 people. Participants need to bring current projects with which to work as well as their sewing machines, hoops, fabric, knitting needles, patterns, and whatever it takes. You can be a beginner who wants to observe, you can be advanced in either craft or simply a "wanna-be" who would like to watch. Space is provided for each person to set up their own private space. Large porches surround the facility for working or reading.

Service projects and stories are shared as a part of this experience. You are encouraged to bring patterns and ideas to share. You may bring a basket to auction for Woman to Woman.

The Kentucky Leadership Center is set in a rural location offering the possibility of quiet walks and beautiful scenery. Meals are provided by an excellent cooking staff. Rooms range from private to quads. They are hotel style with bathrooms in each room. The work space allows for individual working places for all participants. The schedule allows participants to set their own pattern for work, rest, and play. The group will gather for morning and evening prayers.

The retreat will begin with supper on Monday, July 12 and end with breakfast on Thursday, July 15. Registration can be done on the form on the back of this page, or by going on line to the Christian Church in Kentucky website, women's ministries.
