Again this summer we are asking for health insurance information on the camp registration form. If you change insurance plans after returning your registration form and prior to coming to camp please send a photocopy of the front and back of your new insurance card to camp so the staff can have current information. If it is necessary to take a camper to the emergency room during their stay at camp for an illness we will list the family insurance first and the camp insurance as a secondary provider. If it is necessary to take a camper to the emergency room due to an accident at camp, we will list the family insurance as secondary and the camp insurance as primary. Email is only available during the camping season. The director(s) will check email and print for the campers. Email will be given out no more than twice a day. *Please do not send e-cards or photos* because they are awkward to print. Campers will not be allowed access to the computer. All email goes through the director (or director's designee) to the camper.

Grade Completed: CYF: 9-12; Trec: 8-12; Sailing: 7-12; Chi-Rho: 6-8; Junior: 4-5; Mini: 3; Discovery/Camp 101: 1-2; Eighter's: 8.

Things to Bring: Pillow, sleeping bag or 2 sheets and a blanket, casual clothing-shorts, slacks/jeans, shoes, bathing suit, towels, wash cloths, soap, etc. Other: Bible, pencils, notebook, musical instrument, flashlight with extra batteries, stamps, money for canteen and offering. Rainwear is usually needed.

Policies: Smoking is not permitted. No tobacco products (including lighters), alcohol or non-prescription drugs are allowed. Camper WILL BE sent home before the end of the event if these are found. **No "graffiti" of any kind is permitted.**

Campers are not allowed to bring cellular phones, laptops, DVD, CD or MP3 players or any "electronic" gaming system of any kind. DO NOT bring weaponry of any sort (knives, firearms, etc.), candy or other food. These items will be confiscated. Campers are expected to stay the full time and should not leave the camp at anytime without permission of the Camp Director. Any camper driving to camp will not be allowed to leave camp early without written permission of parent or guardian. **VISITORS are Not permitted during camp.**

All Phone messages will be relayed through the adult staff to campers but campers will not be called to the phone. The phone will not be available for campers.

Refunds: If cancellation is necessary notify the appropriate Administrative Camp Office. All cancellations are subject to a \$15 administration fee withheld from the refund. Cancel at least 14 days prior to your event, and the entire registration fee will be refunded. Cancel 13-10 days prior, and 50% of fee will be refunded. No camp fees will be refunded for cancellations less than 10 days prior to the beginning of a camp. No camp fees will be refunded for no-shows the day of camp.

1. Parent/Guardian AUTHORIZATION & ENDORSEMENT: I give my consent for _____ to attend the camp indicated above and to participate fully in the program. In case of medical emergency, I understand that every effort will be made to contact a parent or guardian of the camper. In the event I cannot be reached, I hereby grant permission to the physician selected by the camp staff to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for and to order injection, anesthesia or surgery for child while attending camp. I/We further release the camp director(s) and staff, Christian Church In Kentucky Region and Christian Church In Kentucky-West Area from responsibility and liability for any accidents or illnesses occurring during camp. I/We also authorize the camp director or medical supervisor to dispense non-prescription drugs (i.e. Tylenol; ibuprofen) if the situation warrants. I understand that the camping experience grows in intensity as the week progresses. I recognize that missing any part of the week compromises my child's experience of Christian community and affects both my individual child and the camp community as a whole.
