Course Description

Some Christians resist the assertion that Jesus was political. They believe that Jesus was a "religious teacher" who practiced the separation of church and state. They say Jesus was "depolitical" and that we should be too.

The central concept of Jesus' ministry was the "Kingdom (basileia) of God". In the Gospel of Luke, Jesus announced a political agenda. The Lord's Prayer references "daily bread" and "debts".

Jesus, "The King of the Jews", was arrested like an ordinary bandit and crucified between two bandits. The Romans executed him on a charge of imperial sedition.

Because it is difficult to understand why the Roman prefect, Pontius Pilate, would crucify a depoliticized religious teacher, we must re-frame Jesus' life. We will re-contextualize Jesus of Nazareth, examining the Jewish and Roman worlds in which he lived. What are the implications of Jesus' politics for today?

While at Caesarea Philippi, Jesus asked his disciples: "But who do you say that I am?" As disciples of Jesus, our question is: What do you love when you love Jesus? These two questions will guide our exploration into "The Politics of Jesus."
