



Mentor Coordinator/Pastor

Mission Behind Bars and Beyond (MB3), an ecumenical Kentucky 501 (c), is seeking to employ and call someone to serve as its mentor coordinator and pastor. This dual position is one that requires (1) pastoral gifts to serve MB3's affiliated congregation, New Life in Christ Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), which is located inside a women's detention center in Louisville, Kentucky and (2) administrative skills to coordinate and oversee MB3's growing mentoring program. This thirty hour a week position involves overseeing the congregation's weekly worship service, contacting and enlisting participating congregations to lead worship, hosting weekly worship services, preaching once a month, coordinating life skills classes that meet on a regular basis and providing pastoral counseling, when necessary. In addition, the position involves overseeing a growing mentoring program by interviewing potential mentees, connecting mentees with existing mentoring groups, providing oversight to existing mentoring groups and assisting in recruiting mentors.

The mentor coordinator/pastor reports directly to the executive director and works closely with MB3's volunteers, student interns and participating churches. A Master of Divinity degree from an accredited program is a minimum requirement, standing in either The Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) or the United Church of Christ is preferred.
