

COVID INFORMATION

Upon arrival at camp, please remain in your vehicle until approached by camp staff who will provide instructions for registration. For CYF, Eighters', and Chi Rho camps, adults must remain in their vehicles at all times. For Junior and Mini camps, adults may assist children to their cabin but may not enter. Camp staff will be present to provide any needed assistance.

Overnight camps will be limited to no more than 60 campers, 6 campers and 1 counselor per cabin. Campers will be assigned bunks adequately distanced and will sleep head to toe. Ventilation fans will run continually when cabins are occupied. **Pack an extra blanket as it will be chilly at night.**

There will be daily temperature checks for all campers and staff, conducted in their cabins. If an individual has a temperature of 100.4° or higher, or if they show any COVID symptoms, they will remain in their cabin for an hour and then retested. If there is no improvement, the individual will be moved to the isolation cabin, and a parent, guardian, or the pre-designated adult must come and remove the individual from camp. **Please plan for this eventuality and identify who will pick up the camper and tell us who that will be when we make contact. The camper must then be tested for COVID as soon as possible, and Dave Carr must be notified of the results at dave@ccinky.net.**

Cabins will be sanitized twice daily. The disinfectant is safe for all surfaces. We recommend personal hygiene items be packed into luggage at all times. The dining hall will be sanitized follow every meal. The bathhouse will be sanitized following morning and evening showers.

Adults that wish to serve as directors or counselors must receive a COVID vaccine if they have been authorized. **No adults who have refused to receive a COVID vaccine will be allowed to serve on the camp staff.**

All campers and counselors must provide documentation of receiving a COVID vaccine or a negative COVID test performed within 3 days of the first day of their camp.

Masks will be required at all times except during meals, showering, brushing teeth, ingesting medicine, and when sleeping. **As masks may be damaged or lost, campers should bring several.**

Social distancing will be observed at all times. Campers will stay with their cabin unit for meals and small group activities. During camp-wide activities campers, will sit with their cabin.

All campers and counselors must bring their own water bottle(s). There will be several designated times for no touch filling of bottles each day.

During free/recreation times, designated sanitation protocols will be strictly enforced and regulated for safety.

If a camper refuses or is unable to follow designated protocols, they will be required to wait in the isolation cabin until a parent, guardian, or pre-designated adult can remove them from camp.

All individuals attending camp should self-quarantine as much as possible for 10 days prior to the first day of their camp.

As the COVID situation changes, our protocols may require updates. We will communicate all changes via email.
