

WKDH Camp Info: Camp Rules, Guidelines, Communication Methods, and More!

(Updated January 2026)

Camper Medical Protocols

1. **Emergencies:** In case of a family emergency, call the camp at (606) 787-6564 and ask for a Camp Director. If a camper needs emergency medical care, a director will contact the parent/guardian.
 2. **Medications:**
 - Send all medications (prescription and OTC) in their original containers.
 - Include a list with dosage and frequency.
 - Required emergency meds (e.g., EpiPens, insulin) must be brought to camp or the camper will be sent home.
 3. **Insurance:** Please include all medical insurance information on the registration form. If a camper requires hospital care, the family's insurance will be billed as primary.
 4. **Health and Safety Protocols:** Camp WKDH reserves the right to put protocols in place in response to any potential medical situation that could endanger campers, staff, or their family members. This includes masking, social distancing, personal sanitation, or other recommendations made by local, state, and federal agencies. We will provide as much notice as possible should we consider these actions necessary.

Camp Rules

1. **Prohibited Items:** Campers found with drugs, alcohol, weapons, fireworks, tobacco products, or vape devices will be sent home.
2. **Vandalism:** No graffiti. Campers/parents will be responsible for repair costs.
3. **Attendance:** Campers must remain at camp for the full session unless excused by the Camp Director.
4. **Early Departure:** Campers who drive themselves may not leave early without written parent/guardian permission.
5. **Visitors:** No visitors are allowed during camp. Campers must be registered and approved by the Camp Director—no walk-ins.

6. **Departure Times:** The camp Closing Circle is important. If you arrive before the departure time, please remain in the parking lot until Closing Circle is finished. Please arrive within 30 minutes of departure time.

Cancellation/Refund Policy

- If cancellation is necessary, please notify the CCK regional office at (859) 233-1391 or email WKDH Executive Director Steven Straub at steven@ccinky.net.
 - Full camp fees are due prior to the start of each camp unless a church and/or the region has agreed to pay a portion of the camp fee.
 - Churches will be billed for their portions of the camp fees at the conclusion of the summer camping season.
 - Refunds will be issued to campers who cancel 14 days prior to the start of camp.
 - Families and churches are expected to pay the full amount for campers that cancel less than 14 days prior to the start of camp. Any exception (medical emergency, death in the family, etc.) to this policy must be discussed and cleared with the Executive Director of Camp WKDH.

Gender-Sensitive Housing

To ensure all campers feel welcome, we offer gender identity-sensitive housing at **CYF**, **Eighters**, and **Chi Rho** camps.

- Campers who do not identify with a specific gender
- Campers whose identity does not align with traditional gender roles
- Campers comfortable sharing a space with LGBTQ+ peers

To request this housing option, indicate your preference on the camp registration form.
