**Arrival/Departure Details:** Participants arrive between 7:00 and 8:30 pm on Friday, April 17. Event concludes on Sunday morning at 10:15 am (please arrive on time). Participants should eat dinner before they arrive on Friday evening.

**Registration:** Registration is by church ONLY. Churches are expected to provide their own leadership to stay with youth in the cabins. Ratio of youth to adults should be 1 adult for every 5 youth of each gender.

**Registration Deadline:** All registrations must be received by Wednesday, April 1. *Registrations received after this date will be accepted as space permits.*

# Packing List for the Spring Youth Retreat

## What to Bring

Pillow

Sleeping Bag/Sheets

Casual Clothing-Shorts, Jeans, Shirts, Shoes, etc.

Soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.

Towels and washcloth

Musical instruments are welcome but optional

Flashlight with batteries

Medication (all medicine is given to the camp nurse at check-in)

Raincoat

Water bottle

Work gloves (if you have some)

IPOD or other music device with headphones for use in cabin only.

Bible (will be provided as needed, but you are welcome to bring your own)

**Be sure to mark your belongings!!!!**

## What not to bring

Laptops

Portable DVD players

Video game systems, etc.

Weapons of any kind

Fireworks

No alcohol or drugs are permitted at camp

Tobacco products in any form are not permitted at camp. This includes e-cigarettes and vaping products.

**NO CANDY, SNACKS, DRINKS OR FOOD ARE ALLOWED IN THE CABINS,** they attract wildlife. If the camper has a special snack for dietary reasons, turn it in at check-in.
